Now it is great to all be back at school, where we will be spending at least the first few weeks helping to ease the children back into their learning routines, and identifying key gaps which can then be targeted and built on.



In order to remain compliant with government Covid-secure guidance, I have reviewed and updated our risk assessment. Please note:

Children will each have their own plastic wallets for frequently used resources.

Homework will be set on Google Classroom, with paper versions available if needed.

There will be some staggering of break, lunch and assembly timings in school for Autumn term for separation purposes. We will not be offering after-school clubs this term, but will review this for Spring and Summer 2021. Please see our attached FAQs document for more information.

Parents' Evenings <u>are</u> currently planned to take place on 14th and 15th October, with social distancing protocols in place. More information will follow in due course.

In staff changes, we are welcoming two new teachers to Abbeys—our former student teachers Miss Collins in Westminster and Miss Little in Melrose. Miss Freeman moves to join the Early Years team, whilst Mrs Duncan is now in Marham. We said goodbye to Miss Smith at the end of last year and wish her well in the next step of her teaching career.

Contact Details and End of Day Arrangements

We need at least two contact numbers as well as an email address and the end of day arrangements for every child. Please let us know if there are **any changes** to the information we hold for your child, using the attached contact details form. Without permission we will not be able to release your child to an adult that you have not identified to us, or let them walk home alone at the end of the school day. If there is a one-off change to end of day arrangements (such as someone different picking up), please call to let us know. We also need a quick call if you have been held up and may be late.
