Summer 1 2025 Year 1 and 2 - Curriculum Overview and Homework Activi-



Our learning

This term, our topic is 'Castles'.

During our **English** lessons, we will focus on consolidating our poetry knowledge by recognsing recurring literacy language through shape poems, Acrostic poems, rhyming couplets and performance poetry. The children will learn to write setting

descriptions, using the knowledge they have previously learnt from retelling fiction stories. The children will be learning how to write traditional stories and writing a non-chronological eport focusing on their sentence structure as well as their punctuation and letter formation .



In Maths, Year One children will be learning multiplication and division, fractions and money, finding change and solving two step problems, as well as multiplying and dividing amounts; making equal groups and sharing out amounts practically by 2s, 5s and 10s. Year Two children will learn fractions and time, focusing on O'clock, guarter past and guarter to as well as telling the time to 5 minutes. In our History lessons will be focusing on our main topic 'Castles', learning who worked in castles, knowing how they were defended, the use of castles and learning who William the Conqueror was. In our Science lessons we will be learning about seasonal changes. In our Art lessons, we will be learning about Paul Klee and John Pipers art of castles, looking a different sculptured clay castles. In **PSHE**, the children will be learning about how we respect ourselves and our community. In **Computing**, we will be learning about handling data, creating and recording data on pictograms. The **PE** focus this half term is ball games and tennis.

Please remember to listen to your child read as many times as you can and record it in their planner. If your child is using Read Write Inc, please read the e-book on Oxford Owl and then the book bag book sent home each week. The children will be tested on their weekly spellings on a Thursday and Maths homework sheets will be provided weekly. This must be brought in by Wednesday each week to be marked.
