As Readers we will:

be learning new sounds during our Phonics sessions and will practise using our sound knowledge to blend. We will be listening to and joining in with a range of books during our Literacy lessons. We will be making use of our talk partners to discuss events that happen in the story and begin to think about what might happen next.

As Writers we will:

be using the sound knowledge that we have developed during Phonics sessions to begin our writing journey. We will be learning how to write our names and practise segmenting CVC words to write labels and lists. We will have independent opportunities to write letters, lists and postcards in the Role Play area.

As Mathematicians we will:

be developing our confidence in counting and number recognition. We will be using our skills during learning activities; in games and hidden in the role play such as the post office. We will also be looking at shapes around us and seeing if we can identify them in our environment.

As Investigators we will:

be learning all about ourselves, recognising the similarities and differences between us. We will be learning use the 2simple painting program to 'draw' pictures of our faces on the computer. We will also be learning about some of the people who help us, including, the police and fire service.

As Athletes we will:

be learning how to move safely in a given space and how to take turns. We will be learning how our body moves. We will also be learning how to throw and catch a ball. PE for both classes is on a **Monday**. Please bring PE kits to school every Monday and we will send these home when we are finished with them for the week.

As Artists we will:

be experimenting with paint and collage to create portraits of ourselves and each other. We will explore using a variety of art and everyday materials to create pictures using a range of techniques.

In PSED we will:

be learning about the Golden Rules of the classroom. We will be busy learning the routines of being at school. We will be learning the importance of being a good friend.
