









 <p>Design Technology Create your own crown, knight's helmet or princess' hat – known as a hennin.</p> 	<p>Reading Children must read with an adult for ten minutes each day. Use their Reading Buddy account to find a selection of books to read or choose books from your own reading collections to read to a family member.</p>	<p>Greater than less than. Design your own Top Trumps cards for; Kings, Queens, knights, princesses, princes, Jesters and dragons. Include information about each character, such as; strength, age and power. Give each key aspect a numerical value.</p> <p>What card has the greatest  strength value? What card has the lowest power value?</p>
