Can you add labels to your design and explain how it will keep them safe?</p>	<p><u>Reading</u> Children should be reading for ten minutes each night. Measure the length of hair of 2 different people at home. Who has the longest hair?</p>

Make sure that you weigh the ingredients carefully.</p>	<p> Write a set of instructions for the perfect porridge. Can you create a recipe to make the perfect porridge for Goldilocks?
