<p>Beautiful Butterfly</p> <p>Write about the changes that a caterpillar goes through to become a butterfly.</p>	<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Children should be reading for ten minutes each night. Please initial in their planner so that we can reward them with a star.</p>	<p>Butterfly Addition</p> <p>There are 4 purple butterflies, 3 yellow butterflies and 6 blue ones. How many butterflies are there in total?</p>
<p>Quizmaster!</p> <p>Create a quiz for a friend to answer questions about the life cycle of a chick.</p>	<p>Super Stories!</p> <p>Can you write a story that involves a chick hatching? Think about using expanded noun phrases and exclamation marks.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"></p>	<p>Time</p> <p>A chicken lays its egg at 3 O'clock. The egg hatches at half past 4. How long did it take the chick to hatch?</p>
<p>Get Creative!</p> <p>Create a suitable home for a butterfly or a chick. Use recyclable resources only!</p> <p style="text-align: right;"></p>	<p>Diary Entry</p> <p>Imagine you have just witnessed a chick being born. Write a diary entry about what has happened, what you saw and how you felt. Don't forget to start with 'Dear Diary'.</p>	<p>Butterfly Fraction Challenge</p> <p>A butterfly has 2 sections on each wing. I shaded in 1 section.
