Find a Roman recipe and make it. Please take a photo so we can see it. What did it taste like? Did you enjoy it?	Write a fact file about a Roman God or Goddess.
Write a secret message using Roman Numerals instead of letters (Ask if you need a list of Roman numerals)	Write a diary entry, imagining that you are a Roman soldier who has spent a very long time at war and away from his family.
Create a Roman sword, shield, helmet or body armour.	Compare Roman life to life today. Write a list of similarities and differences.
Create a Roman Toga using an old bed sheet, take a photo of you wearing it.	Create a poster, encouraging boys to sign up to the Roman Army.
