Try to use some ambitious vocabulary.</p>  	<p>Create some word problems based around the Wizard of Oz characters. Remember to answer them</p>
<p>Design an advert for your own Ruby slippers for Dorothy to wear. Label them to show what features they have and use positive adjectives e.g. beautiful or luxurious.</p> 	<p>Write a newspaper report on what happened in the Wizard of Oz. Remember to include details on the 5 Ws and 1H!</p>  	<p>Create some multiplication and division questions Dorothy could ask whilst they heroes travel along the road.</p> 
<p>Create a poster explaining how to be brave and the importance of feeling brave.</p>	<p>Write a book review about 'The Wizard of Oz'.</p>	<p>Draw and label a diagram of the yellow brick road. Include the measurements of a real brick.</p>
<p>Use a map to find out where the city of Kansas is. What country is it in? What is the climate like? Compare what the climate is like in Kansas to the UK.</p> 	<p>Create your own characters that have different things that they are missing and need the Wizard of Oz to give them. How does this affect each character?</p> 	<p>Draw a picture of Oz using 2D shapes. Label each shape you use e.g. heptagon</p> 
<p>Using recycled materials, create your own character from the story</p> 	<p>Imagine you are Dorothy writing a letter to her family from Oz. What would you tell them? Write your letter in character.</p>	<p>Use squared paper to draw a character from Oz. Can you reflect the image?</p>
<p>Write a rap that the characters could sing as they travelled along the yellow brick road (using rhyme).</p> 	<p>Write a shortened version of the story, 'The Wizard of Oz' or write your own version using your own characters.</p> 	<p>Create some fractions questions using flying monkeys. E.g. there are 12 monkeys, $\frac{1}{4}$ are red. How many would this be?</p>
