Topic	English
<b>DT</b> Create your own 3D animal model.	Write a set of instructions on how to build your bug hotel. Make sure that they are clear and easy to follow.
<b>Geography - Local investigation</b> Research Bletchley, what is it famous for? Who is it famous for? Present your research as either a PowerPoint, leaflet or poster.	Create a fact file of an animal of your choice. Include pictures and information on their habitat, their size, whether they are herbivore, omnivore or carnivore, nocturnal or daytime animal.
<b>Science</b> Research and create a mind map of the different insects and bugs that you might find outside or in your garden.	<b>'The best material for a bug hotel is wood'</b> . Do you agree with this statement? Write a for and against debate explaining your answer.
<b>Art</b> Research an artist who paints using watercolours. Include some examples of their work, information on them including date of birth, place of birth, their most famous painting.	Design your own species and create an advert to persuade people to come to the zoo and see it.
<b>DT</b> Design and create a bug hotel to put outside. Think about which materials and design would be most suitable.	Write your very own story about a bug that lives at the bottom of the garden. Think about its habitat and what it looks like! Is it friendly, is it scary?
Watch a wildlife programme and write an explanation on how they are adapted to their environment.	Write a poem (of your choice) on an animal, bug, or habitat.
