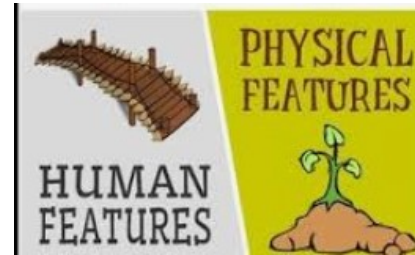
As Scientists we will:
